The ambient air quality impact analysis and health risk assessment for the Porterville Riverwalk Marketplace II project were reviewed. San Joaquin Valley Air Pollution Control District dispersion modeling and health risk assessment procedures were followed. The analyses demonstrate that the project will not cause or contribute significantly to a violation of a State or national ambient air quality standard and that all health risks that might be due to emissions from the project sources are below the District's significant threshold levels.
